Preparing for Full-Time, In Person, On Campus Learning

Please do the following things to prepare for full-time, in person, on campus learning:

1. Complete your daily health check at home.

If the answer is yes to any question, you must stay home. Contact your healthcare provider, and notify NHS.

2. Prepare your materials.

Bring the following items to school every day.

Required:

These items will be checked out to you on the first day of school:

- fully charged NHS laptop
- NHS laptop charger
- NHS laptop bag/sleeve
- NHS headphones/mic
- NHS wired mouse

If not accepting items provided by NHS, you must bring these items from home:

- clean CDC approved mask (if not accepting the mask provided by NHS)
- healthy, nutritious lunch (if not accepting the lunch provided by NHS)
- 2-3 bottles of water (if not accepting the bottled water provided by NHS)

You must bring these items from home:

Required:

Aside from laptop and laptop accessories which will be checked out to you on the first day of school, the yellow highlighted items are the only required supplies.

- Bring these required school supplies in a labeled large Ziploc bag or small storage container to be left at school: notebook paper, pens, pencils, erasers, small pencil sharpener.

Optional:

Other optional school supplies that may be left at school in labeled large Ziploc bag or small storage box if desired:

- calculator
- sticky notes
- highlighters
- markers
- colored pencils
- copy paper/drawing paper
- free reading book

3. Prepare for school arrival.

Bus riders:

Put on and properly wear a clean CDC approved mask, use hand sanitizer, and maintain physical distanced seating.

Other riders:

Drivers pull into a parking place and remain in car. Students put on clean CDC approved mask, leave the car, maintain physical distancing, and walk to Homeroom class.

4. Prepare for contactless health screening and temperature check upon entering Homeroom class.

When you arrive at the door of your Homeroom class, your Homeroom Teacher will use a touchless thermometer to check your temperature and ask you some health screening questions. If you pass the health screening, you may enter the classroom, use hand sanitizer, and go to your assigned workspace. If you don't pass the health screening, your teacher will instruct you to return to your vehicle for transportation home.
